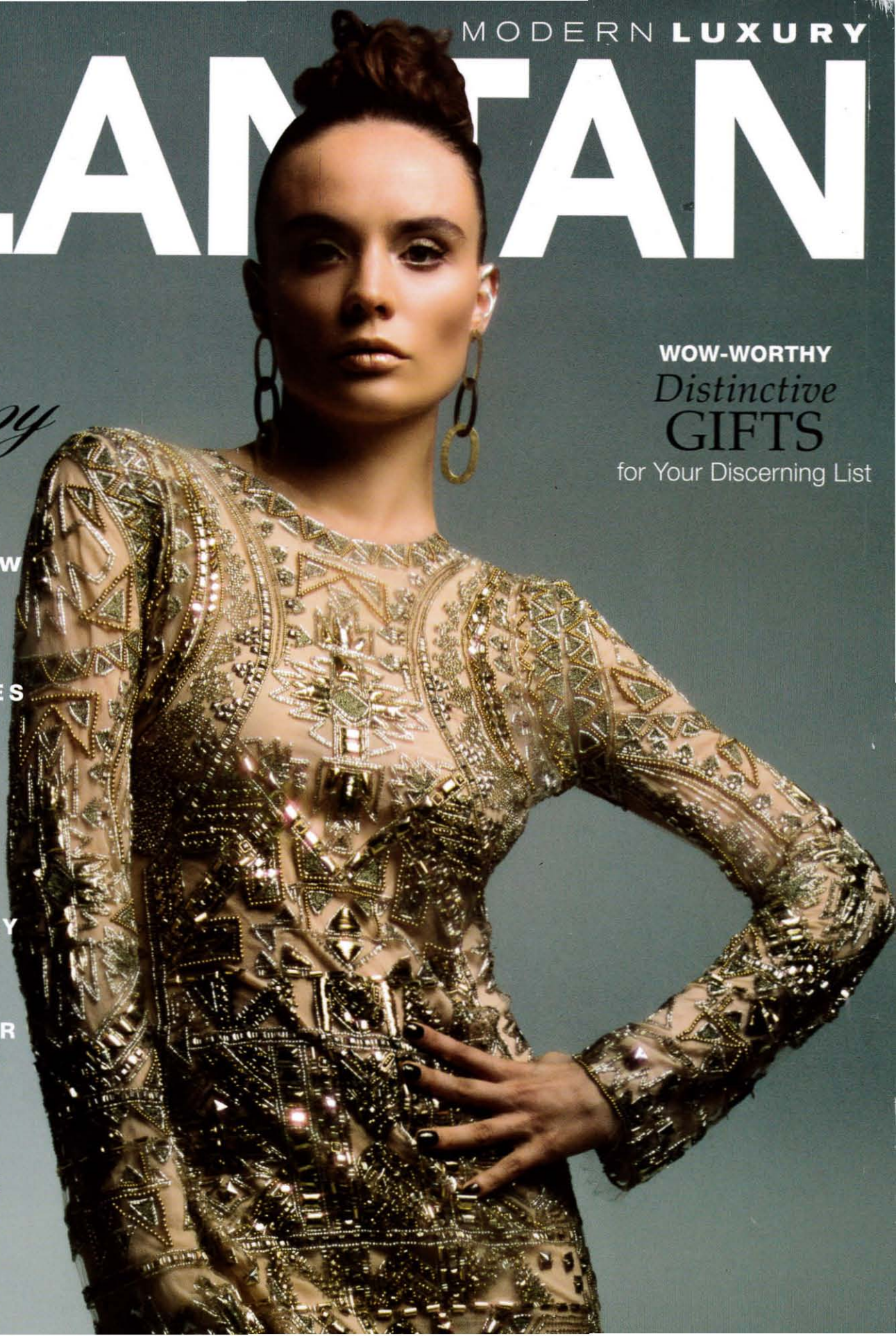

NOV. 1**The Legendary Party**

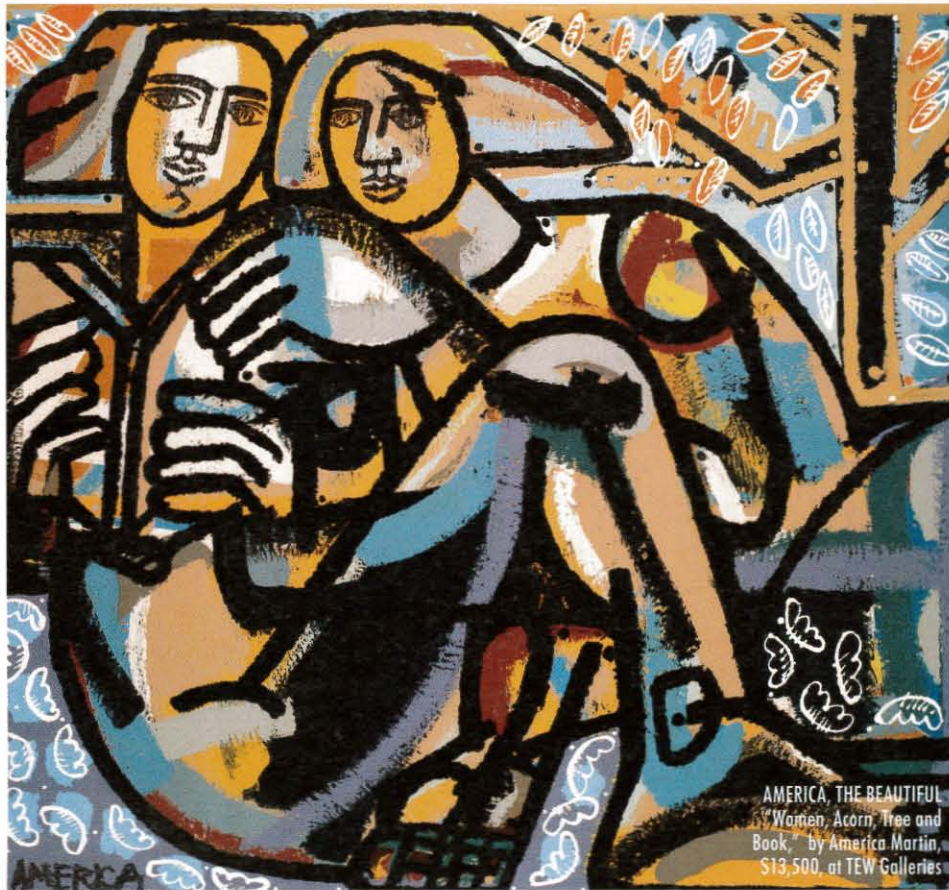
